Let's use some of the new words you have learned and write a Maple poem. Your poem could be about the woods, Maple, Spring or trees. You might choose to write a Cinquain, or a Limerick, a Shape poem, or you may know other types of poems too. Try one that you like.

Example of Cinquain: it has a verse of 5 lines that do not rhyme.
